

Commentary

Emerging markets underperformed developed market peers in November driven partly by strong gains in the U.S. market following Donald Trump's election victory, which also spurred a rally in the U.S. dollar. In China, a market correction following the September stimulus-driven rally, coupled with negative sentiment over potential higher tariffs under a Trump presidency, weighed on performance.

Over the period, the Mobius Investment Trust's (MMIT) net asset value per share (NAV) and share price returned -1.3% and -0.9% respectively, while the MSCI EM Mid Cap Index Net TR (GBP) returned -1.9%. The main contributors to November performance were software provider EPAM Systems (+1.1%), Taiwanese copper clad laminate producer Elite Material (+0.5%), and Indian software provider Persistent Systems (+0.4%). The main detractors to November performance were Taiwanese electronic ink produced E Ink (-0.5%), Brazilian gym chain Smart Fit (-0.4%), and Brazilian jewellery brand VIVARA (-0.4%).
